Health Room News: The health room is located in the main office. Students will need a note from their teacher to visit the health room. Due to limited space, students not exhibiting visible signs of illness or injury within 10 minutes will be sent back to class.

Health Action Plans: Updated and signed health action plans can be turned into the health room or main office.

Immunizations:

- Immunization records of students who attended one of our Jeffco feeder schools has been transferred to KCMS.
- If your student is **NEW** to the Ken Caryl area or your student attended another elementary school, please provide your immunization record during the first week of school if you haven't done so already. Students new to Colorado have a 14-day grace period to be compliant or submit a written plan for completion.
- Free or low cost vaccines are available at Family Health Line, by calling 303-692-2229 or 1-800-688-7777.

Medications: All Medication must be kept in the health room at all times in the ORIGINAL CONTAINER. A signed [medication agreement form](#) is required. Separate forms are required for students with Asthma, Allergies-Anaphylaxis, and are available on the Health page under Family Resources or from the school office.

Tylenol is no longer supplied by the District. Parents may supply a **small bottle** of Tylenol or Ibuprofen for headaches, braces, cramps, etc. A physician signed [medication agreement form](#) is required before we can dispense Tylenol or Ibuprofen.
